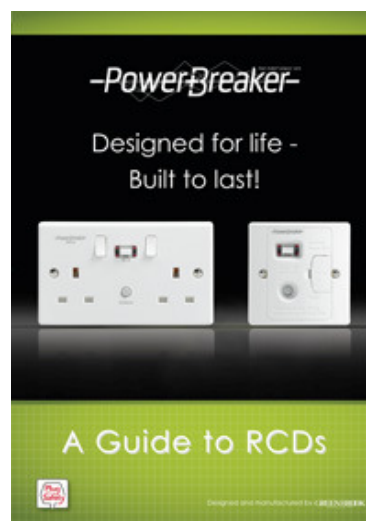




## GREENBROOK'S NEW RCD GUIDE KEEPS SAFETY INFO CURRENT
